Early Childhood Assessment

- Enter the assessment on the Test screen of the Student Side in MIS2000.
- The **Pre** and **Post scores** should be entered into **one test line**. You should be able to see both scores on the same line when clicking on the test name.
- The test must be “linked” to the enrollment line in which the Pretest was done. Example: if the Pre-test was given in October 2014, the test will be linked to enrollment of 09/01/14.
- When **entering the Post-test**, you need to also **enter number of hours** since the Pre-test. The hours are the number of hours tutors helped the students with **School Readiness** until the student received the Post-test.
- If a student moved across districts within your area (which created a new enrollment line), you still enter the Post-test to the original line with the Pre-test.

Only one test line for Pre and Post tests

2013/14 Performance Year: It is expected that DSs entered the Pre and Post in one test line for last performance year (09/01/13-08/31/14).

2014/15 Performance Year (Current): It is expected that the ECA information for this current performance year (09/01/14-08/31/15) will have AdminDate, Pre, Post and *Hours since Pre-Test* (School Readiness) in one test line.

IMPORTANT! SUMMER 2015: If a pre-test is given during SUMMER 2015 but post-test is given after the end of summer, DSs must enter the pre-test attached to the summer line (06/26/15) and **ALSO** create a new test line with pre and post-test for 2015 School year (09/01/15) with a date for pre-test as 09/01/15.

Assessments Scenarios

- All students with Assessment information need to have **Test Name, Score, Date, Interpretation, Present, Tested, and Exempt**
- **Tested:** If a student was present and tested, please enter **Present=Y, Tested=Y, Exempt=N**
- **Absent:** If the student was absent during the week or day of the exam please enter **Present=N, Tested=N, Exempt=N**
- **Exempt:** In this case, please enter **Present=Y, Tested=N, Exempt=Y**
- **Opt Out:** Due to changes on NYS curriculum and assessments, many students are deciding to opt out of the assessment. In such case, the student should still have a line for the test with the following information: **Present=Y, Tested=N, Exempt=N**
- **Departed:** If the student departed prior to the assessment, you do not need to add information about the assessments.

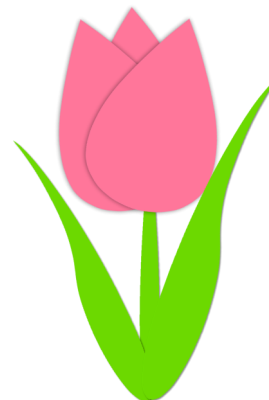
