Process of Handling Level 2 Data:

- Recently, ID&R distributed the initial Level 2 Data
 Report to METS Directors. This report created by the
 Information Reporting Services (IRS) contains K-12,
 and possibly P3-P5, students that have been
 flagged as migrant by school districts across NYS
 between 07/01/16-06/30/17. Please refer to the doc
 "Directions for Handling Flash drive Data
 Reconciliation" for descriptions of the tabs.
- Please import into MIS2000 all students' NYSSIDs included on the tab "IDs to enter of MIS". You can also use the information on the tab labeled "L2 Data" to check if you have on MIS the proper school building (facility) names, DOB, spelling of names or Grade.
- Also, help your Director review all students on the tabs "Under Reported" and "Over Reported". Since the Level 2 report shows students that were enrolled and/or receiving district services and were flagged as migrant eligible between 7/1/16 to mid-February, it will not be a perfect match with current MIS2000 information. However, it will give you a base to start contacting school districts and help correct any discrepancies.
- Document all phone calls, emails, etc to school districts in order to fix any issues on the **Data Reconciliation Form (DRF)**.
- IMPORTANT: when done completing the DRF and importing the data on MIS2000, please erase the Level 2 report from flash drive.
- **Directors:** The **due date** to send the DRF to ID&R is **4/14/17**. Remember to pw protect doc if PII is included.
- Data Specialists: The due date to have the NYSSIDs added to MIS2000 is 4/28/17.

Friendly Reminder:

- 3/3/17 is the last day to enter on MIS any EasyCBM ELA Reading Comprehension raw scores for students tested during the Winter Testing Window
- Applications for migrant scholarships are due 4/1/17
- Data Reconciliation form for SY2016-17 Initial Level 2 report is due to ID&R Office by 4/14/17
- Any missing student data including: NYSSID, facility name, DOB, etc. must be entered on MIS2000 by 4/28/17

MSIX Action Codes

- Recently, we added three new fields on the Student side/School History tab on MIS2000 that will help us track MSIX usage by Data Specialists.
- MSIX Searched: Every time you received a new COE, search for the student(s) on MSIX. After doing so, please click on the MSIX Search box.
- MSIX Arrival Notification: Click on this field after you send a move notice via MSIX for a new student in your area which was previously enrolled in a different state
- MSIX Departure Notification: Click here after you have send to another state the departure notification via MSIX about a student moving from you area to theirs
- **IMPORTANT:** While these processes are not new for Data Specialists, we hope these fields will provide evidence of MSIX usage throughout NYS.

New MSIX Fields

As of September 1, 2016 we started the discussion of the following MSIX Data fields: Out of State Transcript, Residency Verification Date, Graduation/HSE Date, Graduation/HSE Indicator, Algebra 1 or Equivalent Indicator.

However, we recently made some changes on the MIS2000 Student side to ensure the proper communication of these fields with MSIX. All the changes are discussed on the **DS Fast Facts for SDP.** The two major changes are:

- 1. Algebra 1 or Equivalent Indicator was moved from the Student Side Needs Assessment tab to the Student Data Panel
- 2. We also added the *Graduation/HSE Date* and *Graduation HSE Indicator* to the Student Data Panel. **HOWEVER**, we did not change the process of recording students graduating from High School or HSE.
